

"PhonPhai" App for VHVs and provincial public health to show coordinates of the elderly, the disabled, and bedridden patients




The dependent elderly, the disabled who are unable to escape from disasters, and bedridden patients are the vulnerable groups as the first priority for assistance, relocation, and evacuation in case of disasters. This app is a key central database to be utilized by all involved agencies to provide assistance for victims.

VHVs and provincial public health just simply show locations of the dependent elderly, the disabled who are unable to escape from disasters, and bedridden patients via "PhonPhai" App according to the 4 steps as follows.

Download "PhonPhai" App.



Type the word **"PhonPhai"** on App Store / Google Play.




A VHV logs in by username/password using ID card no. Provincial public health logs in by username/password using staff code.




Click **"Vulnerable Group"** to show the location of the elderly/the disabled/ a bedridden patient.



Choose the location of the patient/ the disabled/the elderly. next, click **"ADD."**



Choose nationality. Fill in ID card no./ Type/info of the vulnerable group. Next, click **"SAVE."**



Provincial public health verifies the information.

After verification, the system will display a tick mark before the request.



Note : To show information of patients, the disabled, and the dependent elderly to public health officers for verification in order to be the database for all involved agencies to provide assistance for dependent persons under disasters.
